


## POP CULTURE FESTIVE BORRD

## FROM TIME IMMEMORIAL...

...Freemasons have enjoyed meeting around a "festive board" loaded with the fruits of their labors. Special emphasis was placed on the Summer and Winter Solstices, late in the June and December months, which are celebrated as the Feast of St. John the Baptist, June 24th, and the Feast of St. John the Evangelist, December 27th. It is written, in the first paragraph of the account of the founding of the Grand Lodge of England in 1717 - on the day of the Feast of St. John the Baptist - and was published in the Book of Constitutions, that the old lodges in London had two (and only two) purposes in constituting a Grand Lodge: One was to establish a center of union and harmony, the other was to revive those Quarterly Feasts!
